School Nurse Our School Nurse, Lisa Poole is in school every Friday from 9am—10am. If you would like to make an appointment with the school nurse please ask Mrs Price in the school office.

School Meals Please contact the school office to request a change in meal pattern for the next half term. If your circumstances have changed recently you may be entitled to free school meals. Please contact the school office who can process an application form for you.

Collecting your child Please be reminded that school finishes at 3pm. It can be very upsetting for children when they are not collected on time. If there is an exceptional circumstance where you are going to be late to collect your child, please inform the school office on 01642 243044.

Attendance As many families already will know, the expectation is that a child's attendance at school should be at least 96%. As you would expect, school monitors all attendance carefully. If we are worried about your child's attendance we will invite you to a school meeting with Mrs Smith to discuss school concerns, explain parents' responsibilities, listen to parents and support where we can. The aim for these meetings is to improve a child's attendance and avoid legal proceedings. We must follow recommended policies to ensure that children attend school so that they have the best chance to achieve the very best they can.



Uniform A reminder to parents and carers that children must wear full uniform for school. Jeans, leggings, joggers and trainers are not part of our uniform. Provision for 2, 3 and 4 year olds As many of you know we currently lease our classroom

known as The Children's Centre, to a private day care provider. However, as more and more support in the way of entitlement for 2, 3 and 4 year olds is offered by the government, we along with many other schools have asked for the return of our classroom so we can meet the needs of children attending Breckon Hill Primary School. From September we are able to offer places to 2 year olds in our new Pre-School setting.

If you would like more information about how you can apply for a place in our 2 year old Pre-School from September please go to: http://fis.middlesbrough.gov.uk or contact the school office who can help you find out if you are eligible and help with your application.

If your child is 3 years old, you can usually get 30 hours free childcare if you are:

- In work or getting parental leave, sick leave or annual leave
- Each earning at least the National Minimum Wage or Living Wage for 16 hours a week this is £125.28 if you're over

This earnings limit doesn't apply if you're self-employed and started your business less than 12 months ago. You can find out more at: https://www.gov.uk/help-with-childcare-costs or come and talk to the school office where we will be able to help with your application.
