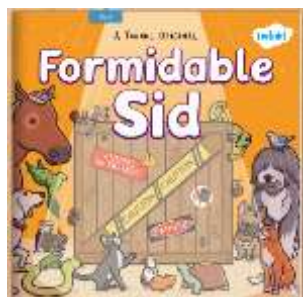

Try writing your name **backwards** to find a good name for your monster

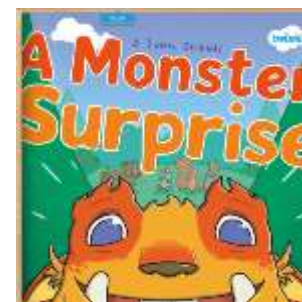
e.g Fiona **A-n-o-i-f**

## Monster munchies

Make lunch for your monster - what does it like to eat? Make a plate and take a photo.

....**then, write** a shopping list for everything you would need to make your monster's lunch.

Remember:

- Write the letters for the sounds you hear.
- Read your words back to check.



## Number puzzle - you need a dice

**Draw a body.** Roll a dice to see how many of each item to draw on your monster.

e.g. eyes...4! legs...5 ears...1! arms...4!



Then, **add them together** by counting on.  $4 + 5 + 1 + 4 = 14$
