
Sea creatures

Sea Sculptures!

Now flour is easier to find... Make some simple play doh and use it to make some sculptures of real, or imaginary sea creatures and corals.

Make labels for your creations: write its name, what it eats, how big it is.

- 1 cup of plain flour
- 1/4 cup of salt
- 3/4 cup of water
- 3 tablespoons of <u>lemon juice</u>
- 1 tablespoon of vegetable oil
- Food colouring

- 1. Mix flour and salt in a bowl.
- 2. Add water, lemon juice, oil and colour mix really well then knead together to make it stretchy.
