Keeping Healthy and Safe

Handwashing: Children are asked to wash their hands when they come to school and regularly throughout the school day.

Water bottles: Children may bring a water bottle to school. They will take it home to be washed and refilled daily.

Book Bags: Children can bring a slim book bag to school to keep their reading books in. Please bring this to school everyday.

Learning

Our Topic: What was the seaside like 100 years ago? We will be learning about the geographic features of the coast and comparing the seaside 100 years ago with the seaside today. In art we will be creating some stormy pictures and in DT we will be designing and making our own hand puppet for a seaside show. In Science we will be identifying the parts of a plant and why they are important.

PE: Children can bring in their own PE kits and PE shoes. These will be put in a named bag on their pegs. We can help provide a PE kit if needed.

Reading books: The children will be given three reading books to keep all week. These will be changed on a Monday. Please read regularly and record this in their reading record.

Homework: We will be beginning to use SeeSaw to upload homework for the children to complete should they wish to. However, if they are unable to access SeeSaw there are other things they can do, we will keep you informed.

Phonics Screening: In response to the Covid-19 pandemic the Department of Education cancelled your child's Year 1 Phonics Screening check. This check will now go ahead within the Autumn Term of Year 2, it will be in the same format as originally planned for Year 1. If you would like to support your child with this check please read daily with your child at home, encouraging your child to "say the sounds and read the word" if they are unsure of a word.
