#### Car Parking

There is a massive issue with Douglas Street car park, we as parents are told its shared car park but all we see is the Stoneacre garage using it we hardly get any space so how is it shared?  
School parking/drop off and pick up is so dangerous! Its very concerning when you cannot stop your children off safely due to the broken vehicles taking over the area and Stoneacre driving in and out of the workshop.

Pick up and drop off for the children coming in cars is very unsafe. It needs reviewing and reconsidering making it more safe.

We will be happy if you are attention safe outside the school as well, always car parking on the school line and no one for stop cars when children want crossing. I hope you agree with me.

### Homework

Teachers lead classes out at home time and are always happy to talk and answer any questions. To be honest there has been so many good changes I can't seem to find any faults. [Response: All our visits are now free to all children. We offer a 3 day residential free to all children in Y6.](#)
