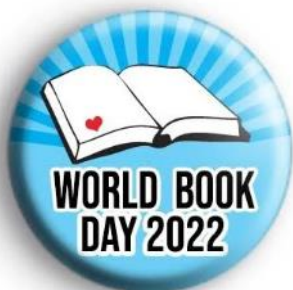


## Class Year 4 Newsletter

## This half term we will be learning...



### Why are rivers important?

We will begin by learning and understanding about the water cycle, then the children will locate rivers on a map and learn about their physical features. We will then focus on the River Tees and explore and look at how industry has changed the human and physical features of the river. Finally we learn about the effects of environmental change and how that changes our locality.

### In Science we will be learning about States of Matter

Children will learn how to compare and group materials according to whether they are a solid, liquid or gas. They will investigate freezing and melting points of different materials and learn how processes such as evaporation and condensation happen, linking it to how the water cycle works!
