Key Stage 2 children are taking part in this year's film festival with a visit to Cineworld to enjoy a film!

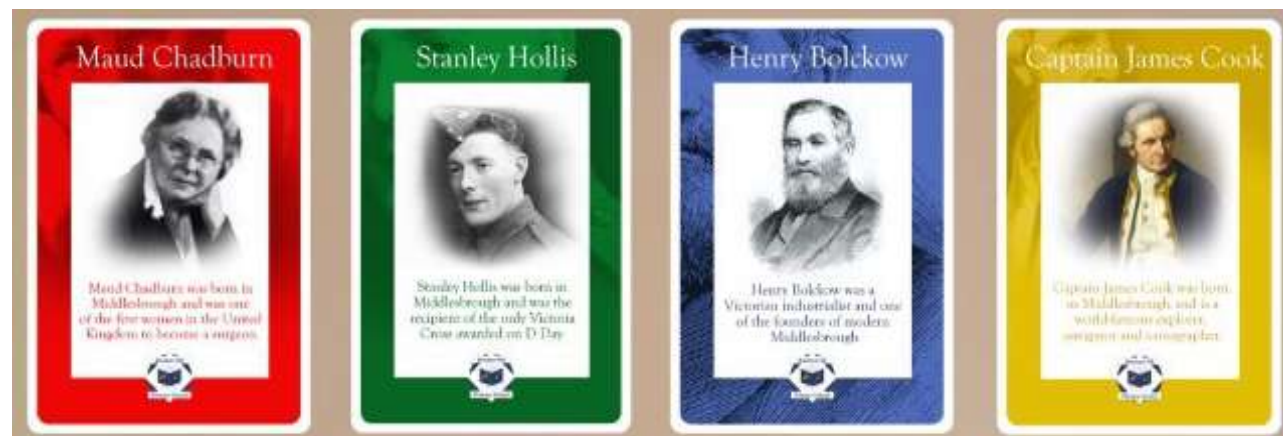

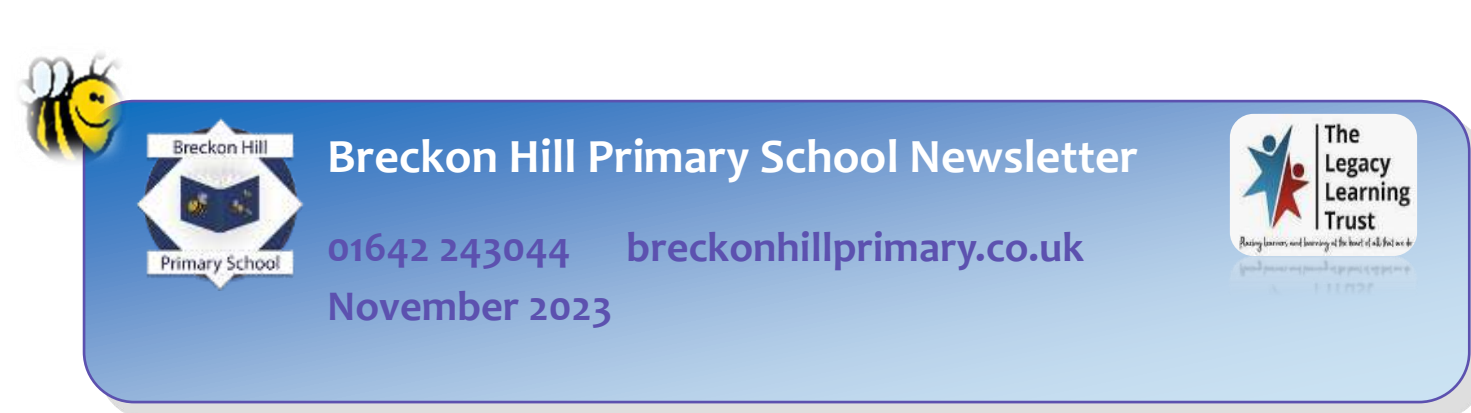
Congratulations to Amine who qualified to go through to the cross country district championships. And well done to all the children who have represented us at competitions this month. Attitude and behaviour has been excellent!
