Health and Safety

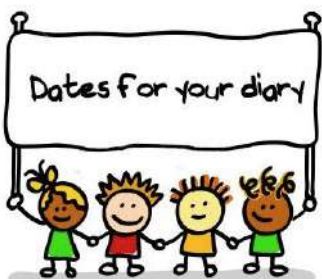
Sorry but for health and safety reasons we are not able to give out birthday cake and treats from home.
