Choir

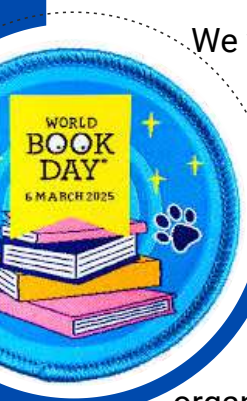
This month we are gathering with the other TLLT schools to enjoy an evening of singing. We hope to have a lovely evening. Thanks for the great work from both children and staff.

BREAKFAST CLUB



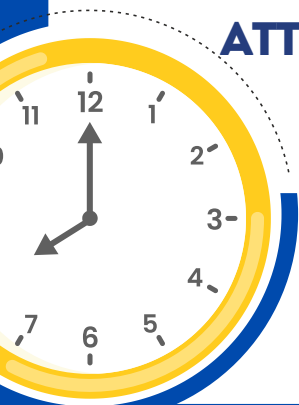
Parents must book a child's place at breakfast club by contacting the school office. The breakfast club is free but for safeguarding purposes we need to know which children to expect each day.

ATTENDANCE AND PUNCTUALITY

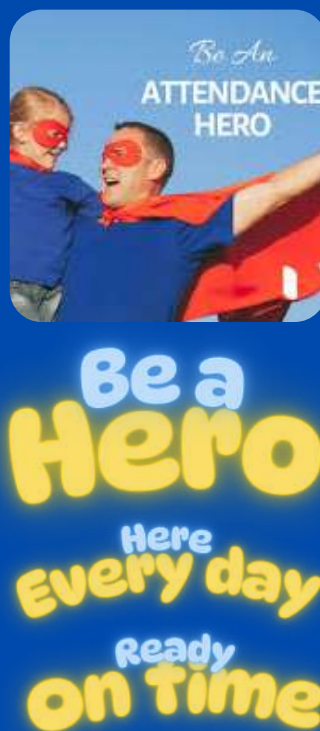
Please bring your child to school every day unless they are poorly. Mrs. Cartwright, our Education Welfare Officer, will contact families where we have concerns.
