**Jars/bottles of:** Coffee , Cooking Oil , sauces

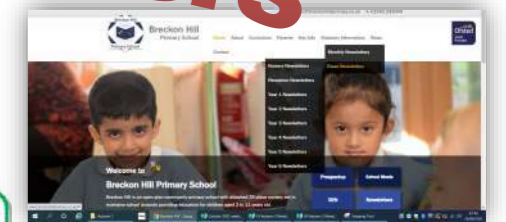
