Our science work links to our design and technology work which is all about joining techniques, we are looking forward to making our own puppets.

In history we will finding out What happened during The Great Fire of London

Children will be using co-ordinates to map The Great Fire of London and show the important places that they have learnt about so far in their history. We will learn about the events that took place and the main reasons for the fire spreading so quickly.

We will be comparing 17th Century London to modern day London using videos and photographs and from any experiences children may have. We will be finding out about characters from the past and why they are important.
