This term we will be learning...

Where in the world is Egypt?



We will start by recapping our knowledge about the continents and oceans of the world.

We will be looking at maps to remember where in the world we live and on which continent we are living in? Can you remember what the equator line is? What is the climate like close to the equator?

We will be finding Egypt on the world map – what do you think the weather will be like in this country? We will be sharing ideas as to how we know this.

We will be looking at ancient civilizations and what made them successful.



In our science we will be learning to identify and describe the functions of different parts of flowering plants: roots, stem/trunk, leaves and flowers.

We will be working scientifically by gathering, recording, classifying and presenting data in a variety of ways to help in answering questions.

Later on in the term we will be learning all about light sources.
