#### Learning Topic

#### What is farming like in the UK?

We are going to be learning more about farming. Farming is the business of growing crops and raising livestock. Around 70% of the land in the United Kingdom (UK) is used for farming and there are many types of farms. Farming is affected by the climate (typical weather), topography (shape of the land) and soil type of the farm's location. There are three main types of farming: arable, pastoral and mixed. In our topic we will be exploring why farming is so important in this country and around the world.

Key Vocabulary

Export: Something that is sent to another country to sell.

Import: Something brought into a country for sale.

Fair Trade: Trade where a fair price is paid to the growers of the product.

**Food Miles:** How long food has travelled from where it is grown to where it is sold.

Supply Chain: The process involved in the making of something e.g. chocolate.

Climatic Zone: An area that has a certain climate or weather pattern.

**Climate Change:** A change in weather patterns mostly caused by an increase in Carbon Dioxide in the atmosphere.



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
