### Welcome to Year 4!

We are so proud of how the children have returned to school. We have started learning about the Romans and why they came to Britain and the children are working very hard! In our school there are lots of people to help. Please email us if you any questions.

**Handwashing:** Children are asked to wash their hands when they come to school and regularly throughout the school day.

#### Learning Topic:

Our question this half term is—*What did we learn from the Romans?* We will be undertaking an archaeological dig to look for ancient artefacts. We will research who founded Rome and who were Romulus and Remus. We will be learning about who the Romans were, why they invaded Britain and what changed here because of the Romans.

**PE kits/ PE shoes needed:** Children are asked to wear black PE shorts, a plain white t-shirt and PE shoes or trainers. We can provide PE kits should you wish us to do so.
