- I will like the food portion to increase as my child as complaint about. Also, the toilet is not well kept neat most times.  
Our experienced kitchen team work to guidelines about portion size. We have a cleaner that comes at lunchtimes to make sure the toilets are kept lean for children.
- It would have been nice if some extra curricular activities like dance, cultural festivals, fancy dress competitions etc are included for kids.  
If there were more after school clubs.  
I will like gymnastics classes please.  
We will make sure suggestions about clubs are put forward to the staff leading. We discourage dressing up days as we do not want to impose additional costs onto families.  
We do usually run a gymnastics club, but the staff member is currently on maternity leave.
- Lunches – son hasn't been happy with new menu for a while
- School lunch meal could be improved and letting young kids know what is on the menu on that particular day will help them feel less anxious when choosing.
- Please keep eye on the food children eat. As it is cold the cold water given is causing health issues to many children. This came to me when I talked with other parents during the school leaving time.  
Our lunchtime menu is on our website, teachers of younger children talk this through daily so children know what to expect. Parents can access the menu at home via the school website.

- More assignments for him practice with at home.
- Doing great so far. Would like to see more apps he can use at home.
- Academic and educational standard. Homework/Assignment. Weekly Reviews.  
We are always reviewing our homework policy as parents and children have mixed feelings about what is/isn't manageable. If you want to talk with us more about how you can help your child, please do not hesitate to contact us.  
Weekly reviews would be hard to manage but the teacher is always happy to give you an update as to how your child is getting on.
- Need to stop kids bullying. I am sorry to hear this, we have a very clear behaviour policy and do not tolerate bullying in any way at all. Please come and talk to me so we can help.
- Not school grounds but bushes at end car park need cutting back to let everyone walk pass. We have asked our grounds contractors to assess all pedestrian areas and action as soon as possible.
- I would like to know about my child's progress and if I am not doing what I am suppose to do as a parent I should be informed especially when it comes to his online lessons. Please speak to your child's class teacher who will be happy to help.
- When pupils are to practice in any sports activities I'll suggest they are better prepared than suddenly facing them without adequate practice, this will prevent them from being stressed out. Our PE and sport's coach are looking to see how we can improve in this area.
- I think there is need to do more for children coming this year from other parts of UK.  
We are interested to learn more. We welcome children into school and hope they feel like they belong to school. Please come and talk to us.
- More parent and student activities and more time and communication with teachers. We try and invite parents into school to learn about the curriculum, meet the teachers and staff and see their children perform in a play each term. Leaders are out and about at drop off and pick up times, so please don't hesitate to chat and tell us more. This half term we have had meetings with Reception and year one families about the curriculum, all families have been invited to meet with teachers and see the classrooms and Y5 families have been invited to watch their child's class performance.
