- On the seesaw app there's not much info on what children (my child) is doing throughout the day. The Seesaw app is to support homework, teachers are not asked to manage the app throughout the day as their time needs to be spent working directly with children.
- One on one time with parents and teachers would enable parents share and understand how best to contribute to total development of child especially in habit/etiquettes etc.
- Giving notification of my kid's improvement and development monthly.
- More information about how they are getting on e.g. regular updates on seesaw.
- More updates on student progress would help.
- We offer three meetings a year and an end of year report to parents, should you like to meet with the teacher between the parents' meetings, please do not hesitate to contact us.
- More clubs / after school activities (sports club). Staff who work at the school are paid to lead after school clubs, we ensure children from Year 1-Y6 get the opportunity to join in over the year.
- I will like the school to improve on the daily homework and not just story books all the time. The school should give something like mathematics, English assignment as well. We will look to review our homework offer. We prioritise reading at Breckon Hill and know that parental support has a hugely positive effect on children's progress.
- Parking near reception (should be made one way). Cars park anywhere, even stopping in middle of road.
- We have problem for car parking to pick up the kids. The school must arrange meeting with Middlesbrough council to recount the road to reduce the car movement. We regularly share and ask for support regarding the parking issues with the council.
