End of term and year evaluation certificate.

Last year, following feedback from parents and carers and teachers we made changes to how we report to parents and give a report with targets in March so families can support. This is followed up with a further report in the summer term. We also report attendance termly. We have three opportunities for parents and carers to come into school to talk with teachers about their child's progress and we have an open-door policy which means parents/carers are welcome to make an appointment to discuss any concerns or worries they may have at any point during the school year.

Shorten the distance between reception class and school main children pick up point. (Douglas street side)

I am sorry but to ensure we safeguard children, we need to make sure we can safely staff entrance and exit routes and therefor have one clear route in and out of our Early Years setting.

There should be separate gates for entrance and exits at main school gates or separating barrier as its safety issue, as one gates opens first and some people take short cut by going through the other incoming traffic.

Thank you for this feedback, we will monitor the playground at home time.

It would be better if the school introduced playing musical instruments for the children starting from Year 1.

We agree that music is important and feel so strongly about this that we employ a specialist music teacher. The children are given the opportunity to enjoy percussion instruments from nursery onwards. Throughout Key Stage 2 children are given the opportunity to learn the recorder and the ukulele, they also have the chance to play in a band in Y4.

Homework support

Parking outside, car park entrance (very dangerous)

We appreciate that this is an issue and will endeavour to encourage parent/carers to park and walk. We have requested barriers to be erected by the council to support with the parking concerns. We operate a flexible start to the day which eases everyone arriving at the same time, however, it is more difficult to implement this system on an afternoon.

Please clean the area near and around the outside school wall, its difficult to walk sometimes.

Our health and safety lead has checked pathways which are all clear, we have reported the outside pathways to the council as we know the leaves can cause a slippery surface to walk on.

Can let the parents know about the what are the extra-curricular activities they have to join in school.

All year groups have a range of extra-curricular activities to join in with throughout the year. Letters come out towards the end of term, so they start promptly on our return from the holidays. Please look out for letters and texts that tell parents when to sign their children up for after school clubs which are free to families.

World book day

At Breckon Hill, on World Book Day, all the children take home a book rather than a voucher, the children had a visit from an author this year and the older and younger children enjoyed sharing stories over hot chocolate/juice and a biscuit. We took the decision some years ago not to dress up as it is costly for families, this is part of our poverty proofing work to ensure school is affordable for all families.
