## This term we will be learning...

### Who were the Ancient Maya? Where do they fit on our historical timeline?

The Maya peoples made their home in an area known as Mesoamerica (modern day Mexico and Central America). We will be learning about Mayan society: how they lived, their beliefs and their achievements and why the civilization declined. We will also be comparing this ancient civilization to another, the Egyptians.

**In Science we will be learning:** To recognise that living things have changed over time and that fossils provide information about living things that inhabited the Earth millions of years ago. We will be working scientifically by presenting findings in a labelled diagram.
