Building Works

**Dear Parents, Carers and Pupils,**

I am writing to inform you about some building works that will shortly be taking place in school.

From 6<sup>th</sup> July, work will begin to divide the larger classroom at the end of the building, next to the EYFS entrance, into two separate classrooms. This development is an important part of our planning for September, ensuring that we have appropriate teaching spaces ready for our new class organisation.

In order for the new classrooms to be completed in time for the start of the new academic year, it is necessary for the builders to begin work before we break up for the summer holidays.

This will mean:

- There will be some increase in noise during parts of the school day, particularly in this area of the building
- Access around the EYFS entrance and surrounding corridor may be slightly adjusted at times
- Temporary barriers may need to be in place to ensure the safety of all pupils and staff
- Contractors will be working on site during the school day, following all safeguarding and health and safety procedures

Please be assured that we will:

- Carefully manage the work to minimise disruption to learning
- Ensure all safeguarding procedures are strictly followed, including supervision and separation of building areas
- Keep all pupils safe and maintain normal routines as much as possible

We appreciate that building work can be disruptive at times, but these improvements will provide better learning environments for our pupils and support the continued development of the school. For pupils directly affected and needing to move classrooms for this work to be completed, we will provide more information to you in the coming days.
